- 1. Name of program: CKLC Language Exchange Program
- 2. Objectives:
 - 1) Providing an opportunity for both CKLC and HUFS students to learn and improve Korean and foreign languages skills.
 - 2) Overall support in everyday life such as buying a SIM card, opening a bank account, using public transportation etc. Throughout this process, we aim for a stable settlement, improvement in language skills and promotion of friendship for foreign students.

3. Outline of the program

- 1) Period: throughout the semesters at this center (4 semesters per year)
- 2) Composition: team staff, foreign students from this center and HUFS students

4. Program plan

- 1) Selection: each semester, team staff will post a recruitment notice through various channels such as HUFS and CKLC homepage, bulletin board in front of the office and classroom and also on orientation guidebooks and presentation screens.
- 2) Registration: students of CKLC and HUFS should come to the office and submit their application forms. After the recruitment period, students will be matched 1:1 and support will be provided for efficient learning. There will be a monthly check-up and evaluation. Other than language exchange, support is encouraged for everyday life and friendship promotion.
- 3) Schedule: recruitment of CKLC and HUFS students → 1:1 matching → orientation → submission of study plan (e.g. learning idioms, phrases, watching foreign TV shows etc.) → interim check → final assessment → completion certificates

5. Benefit

Students who successfully complete this program, a certificate and a small present will be given at the end of the semester. Starting from the winter semester, obtaining credits will also be possible for HUFS students.
