1. for election of one lecturer into a research-teaching position and corresponding employment position of Tenured Full Professor, in the scientific area of Social Sciences, the field of Psychology, the branch of School Psychology and Educational Psychology, in the Department of Psychology,
2. for election of one lecturer into a research-teaching position and corresponding employment position of Tenured Full Professor, in the scientific area of the Interdisciplinary Field of Science, the field of Geography, in the Department of Geography,
3. for election of one lecturer into a research-teaching position and corresponding employment position of Tenured Full Professor, in the scientific area of the Humanities, the field of Philology, the branch of Theory and History of Literature, in the Division of Croatian Language and Literature of the Department of Croatian and Slavonic Studies,
4. for election of one lecturer into a research-teaching position and corresponding employment position of Tenured Full Professor, in the scientific area of the Humanities, the field of Philology, the branch of Theory and History of Literature (older Croatian literature), in the Division of Croatian Language and Literature of the Department of Croatian and Slavonic Studies,

Applicants are expected to meet the requirements of the Labour Act (Official Gazette, no. 93/14), the requirements of the Science and Higher Education Act (Official Gazette, nos. 123/03, 198/03, 105/04, 174/04, 2/07 – Decree of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Croatia, 46/07, 45/09, 63/11, 94/13, 139/13, 101/14 - Decree and resolution of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Croatia, and 60/15 – Decree of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Croatia) and the regulations based therein, as well as the requirements stipulated by other acts.

Gender-related expressions used in this call for applications are used neutrally and refer to both feminine and masculine gender.

Applications should be submitted to the University of Zadar / *Sveučilište u Zadru*, Mihovila Pavlinovića 1, HR-23000 Zadar, Croatia.

Two copies of the following documents should be attached to the letter of application:

- curriculum vitae,
- diploma or degree certificate (for the academic degree) or other documents which may be used as a proof of meeting the requirements for election into a research-teaching position and corresponding employment position of Tenured Full Professor,
- certificate of Croatian or other citizenship,
- certificate of fluency in Croatian (for foreign citizens),
- copy of a decision of election into a research position of Research Adviser,
- list of books, research papers and other papers, grouped into two sections: up to the most recent election, classified according to paper categories, and after the most recent election, classified according to paper categories,
- report on research-teaching activities,
- evidence of positive results obtained by the institutional evaluation of the applicant's teaching performance, or evidence of positive results obtained by student evaluation at an institution of higher education.

Letter of application, curriculum vitae, report on the research-teaching activities and lists of papers should also be submitted in an electronic form (on a CD), in the PDF format, in two copies.

Deadline for application and submission of required evidence is 30 days from the date of publication of the call for applications in the Official Gazette.

Late and incomplete applications shall not be taken into consideration.

Election process will be completed within the legally bound period and the applicants will be notified of the results within 15 days from the completion of the election process.
