### CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

1. for the election of one associate (PhD student) into professional position of a professional associate, for work on the project *Archaeology of Navigation and Shipbuilding in the Adriatic*, for a limited period of time (48 months).

Applicants are expected to meet the requirements of the Labour Act (Official Gazette, no. 93/14), the requirements of the Science and Higher Education Act (Official Gazette, nos. 123/03, 198/03, 105/04, 174/04, 2/07 – Decree of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Croatia, 46/07, 45/09, 63/11, 94/13, 139/13, 101/14 - Decree and Resolution of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Croatia, and 60/15 – Decree of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Croatia) and the regulations based therein, as well as the criteria stipulated by the Croatian Science Foundation.

Mandatory requirements:

- completed graduate studies in the area of the Humanities, the field of Archaeology
- enrolment in a doctoral study programme in the area of the Humanities, the field of Archaeology

Additional requirements:

- participation in scientific research and fieldwork,
- proficiency in the English language (in speaking, reading, and writing),
- multiannual experience in underwater archaeological research,
- professional training abroad for at least one month,
- participation in scientific conferences.

Foreign citizens are required to submit the proof of validation of a foreign higher education qualification issued by the Croatian Science and Higher Education Agency.

With the letter of application, the applicants are expected to submit: Curriculum Vitae, diploma or the certificate of the completion of graduate studies, a photocopy of certificate of Croatian or other citizenship, and evidence of meeting the mandatory and additional requirements.

Applications and attachments should be submitted in two hard copies and on one CD to the following address: University of Zadar / *Sveučilište u Zadru*, Mihovila Pavlinovića 1, 23000 Zadar, Croatia.

Members of both genders are entitled to apply for this call for applications under equal conditions. Gender-related expressions used in this call for applications are used neutrally and refer to both feminine and masculine gender.

Deadline for application is 30 days from the date of publication of the call for applications in the Official Gazette.

Late and incomplete applications shall not be taken into consideration.

Election process will be completed within the legally bound period and the applicants will be notified of the results within 15 days from the completion of the election process.
