Razmatra se ponajviše postkolonijalna knjizevnost dvadesetog stoljeća pisana na engleskom jeziku, sa općim uvodom u knjizevnosti Afrike, Australije, Kanade, Novog Zelanda, Kariba i Oceanije, juzne i jugoistočne Azije te poskolonijalno britansko pismo. Studenti stjecu temeljna znanja iz postkolonijalne teorije stjecu sposobnost teorijske interpretacije takvih tekstova.
