The tests/the final written exam can be taken only at the scheduled time. Students are to come on time for the test/final written exam; otherwise, they will not be permitted to take it. Students who do not accept the test grades are due to take the tests as part of the final written exam. Having passed the final written exam, students are to pass the final oral exam in the summer exam period, they are to take the final written exam in the autumn exam period.
