Application deadlines

Autumn semester: 15 May Spring semester: 15 November

Entry requirements

At least one year of university-level studies. For courses taught in English, the language requirement is level B2. For courses taught in German, the level is C1.

Accommodation

The International Office assists students with finding accommodation, either in the student residence or in a flat-share.

Student life

The Erasmus Student Network (ESN) organises many low-cost events and trips for international students. The Student Association also offers a wide range of social events and sport activities.

Financial support

Students from European partner universities are entitled to a mobility grant funded by the Swiss European Mobility Programme. Students from partner universities outside of the EU can apply to HTW Chur for a mobility grant.

Living expenses

The cost of living is approximately CHF 2000 per month. This includes food and personal care, housing, health insurance, books and school supplies. The amount can vary, depending on your lifestyle.
