The European Blue Sentinels Twinning Project

započeo je s provedbom u **siječnju 2016.** godine s **predviđenim trajanjem do listopada 2016.** godine. **Nositelj projekta** je **Grad Zadar** uz **partnere:** *Grad Dubrovnik, Inverness (Škotska), Grad Gorizia (Italija), Grad Nova Gorica (Slovenija) i Grad Kotor (Crna Gora).* Ukupna **vrijednost projekta iznosi 25.000 eura** te se provedba svih projektnih aktivnosti u potpunosti **financira iz EU Programa „Europa za građane“.**

Projekt se temelji na zajedničkoj potrebi svih sudionika za podizanjem svijesti i znanja o očuvanju mora i vodenih bogatstava, održivom upravljanju vodenim eko-sistemima i pravilnim korištenjima vodenih bogatstava, uključivanjem civilnog sektora i volontera u ekološke akcije kojima se sprječava daljnja onečišćenja plaža i vodenih resursa, prvenstveno mora.

Projekt promiče zaštitu mora i pravilnu valorizaciju morskih resursa kroz organizaciju raznovrsnih popratnih akcije poput čišćenja plaže, demonstracije čišćenja podmorja te kreativne radionice od prikupljenog recikliranog materijala kao i niz predavanja profesora i predstavnika udruga koje se bave ekologijom i zaštitom mora i priobalja.

The European Blue Sentinels Twinning Project

began with the implementation in **January 2016,** with an anticipated duration to **October 2016.**

The lead partner on the project is the **City of Zadar,** followed by **project partners:** *the City of Dubrovnik, Inverness (Scotland), the City of Gorizia (Italy), the City of Nova Gorica (Slovenia) and the City of Kotor (Montenegro).* **The overall project value is 25.000 EUR** and the implementation of all project activities is being fully **financed by the EU program "Europe for Citizens".**

The project is based on the common need of all participants to raise awareness and knowledge about the protection of the sea and water resources, sustainable management of aquatic eco-systems and the proper use of water resources, by involving the civil society and volunteers in different environmental actions to prevent the further pollution of beaches and water resources, mainly the sea. The main activity of the project attended by representatives of all the partners takes place in

ZADAR, FROM MAY 12TH TO MAY 17TH, 2016.

The project promotes the protection of the sea and a proper valorisation of marine resources through various supporting actions such as beach cleaning activities, underwater cleaning demonstrations and creative workshops of the collected recycled materials as well as a series of lectures by professors and representatives of NGOs dealing with ecology and protection of sea and coastal areas.
