

STUDY PROGRAMS

Undergraduate study program: French Language & Literature **(double major)**

Duration of study: 6 semesters.

Admission requirements: Completion of a four-year secondary school and the state baccalaureat

Competencies acquired upon finishing the program: This course is dedicated to acquiring competencies and skills necessary for translators, teaching in related fields, and overall professional advancement. Students will acquire theoretical knowledge in the fields of French civilization, linguistics, language, and French/francophone literature. It will improve their social skills and create an understanding that language acquisition is a lifelong process. Students will also gain general knowledge of French language & literature (B1-B2) which is an excellent starting point for employment in various sectors such as: tourism, publishing, international relations, or research scientist. Aside from the mandatory courses, the study program offers an array of elective courses which enable students to acquire more specialized knowledge that will be beneficial to their specific career path. This program will allow them entry into the graduate program (4th and 5th year), or help in their pursuit of their chosen profession.
