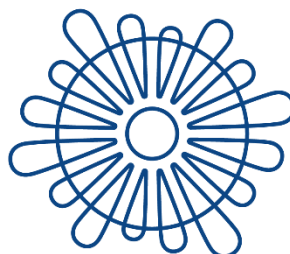

Food	<p>The Ministry of Science and Education provides all Erasmus+ and CEEPUS students with the student card (<i>X-card</i>). The card is issued by the Office for undergraduate and graduate students of the University of Zadar and it costs 50,00 kunas. It enables students to get meals at the discount price at the student restaurant. Other categories of the incoming students are not entitled to get the student card (<i>X-card</i>).</p>
