ABOUT US:

The Department of Hispanic and Iberian Studies, one of the newest university departments, began its work in the 2006/2007 academic year with optional lecturers in Spanish (MAEC-AECID) and Catalan (Ramon Llull Institute). In the 2007/2008 academic year, undergraduate studies in Spanish language and literature and a Galician lectureship (Xunta de Galicia) began, and in 2013/2014 the postgraduate study in Hispanic studies. Including Iberian languages in this way, the University of Zadar belongs to a small but respectable group of European universities (Basel, Liverpool, Padua, Paris III-Sorbonne Nouvelle, Tübingen, Venice, among others) where Iberian studies came to life.

The main objective of the Department of Hispanic and Iberian Studies is to allow students, within the study program, to learn about the linguistic and cultural richness of Spain and the entire Iberian Peninsula, as well as Latin America. The Spanish language and literature degree is intended for students with no prior knowledge of Spanish. In addition to learning Spanish as a foreign language,

students also learn another Romance language, which can be Galician or Catalan. In addition to linguistics and literature courses, students gain knowledge about Hispanic and Latin American history, culture, and civilization.

Through the Erasmus program and bilateral agreements, the department collaborates with numerous European universities (Alcalá, Complutense, Coimbra, Vigo, Valencia, Huelva, Granada, Barcelona, Vigo, etc.), and is also part of the CEEPUS network. A central cultural event is the days of Iberian languages and culture, which are traditionally held in the month of May.
