Description of the course	<p>The course gives an overview of the basic facts about the Roman writers such as Lucretius, Cicero, Seneca the Younger etc. and their works. Further on, the course will attempt to introduce the student to the stylistic and formal developments of rhetorical, philosophical and epistolographic writing in Latin, taking into account social, political and cultural contexts.</p>
