Description of the course	<p>In the course students develop their language skills on level C2. They improve their speaking skills needed for interactive communication and through analyses of a variety of audio-visual materials they get acquainted with cultural norms of the English-speaking countries. Also, students practice expressing their personal attitudes and continue developing critical thinking while discussing different topics. Furthermore, the focus is on the achievement of high standards in reading and academic writing. Vocabulary enrichment includes the study of phrasal verbs, idioms and collocations with the aim of improvement in written and oral communication. Students analyse individual grammatical structures within the grammatical system, thus gradually upgrading their grammatical and translation competence. Students restructure their knowledge doing more complex exercises and translations. Finally, by developing learning strategies students are trained for independent work.</p>
