Description of the course	<p>This subject explores the essential characteristics of the world's languages with the aim of understanding the fundamental principles of the language system. We will study a range of linguistic subsystems – e.g., phonology, morphology, syntax, semantics, discourse – drawing on case studies from languages around the world. An introduction to the related fields of study (sociolinguistics, psycholinguistics, historical linguistics etc.) will also be given.</p>		
Learning outcomes of the course	<p>By the end of the course, students should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • identify the basic elements of linguistic description in the different levels of analysis; • differentiate phonetic description from the insights provided by phonological models; • be able to explain the fundamental concepts related to the realm of the word (word-forms, lexemes, morphemes etc.); • identify the objectives of syntactic description and how they are tackled by different syntactic models; • understand the fundamental concepts and phenomena connected to the level of meaning as conceived independently of the developments in the form of words, phrases and sentences; • orientate among the main areas of study of linguistics; • differentiate between the linguistic approach toward language and the approaches of other disciplines toward it.
