Interpretation of the texts of the John's school on a particular theological theme.</p> <p>After successfully completing the course, students are expected to be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explain scientifically the process of the creation of the Gospel of John, the three epistles of John, and Revelation. • recognize in the writings of Ivan the religious, cultural and social traces of the circumstances in which they were created. • Distinguish, in a diachronic approach, the "layers" of texts that speak of Jesus from those who describe the early Christian community and other groups. • To know thoroughly the New Testament texts of the Ivanov scriptures, but also the study methodology, with the aim of making this process of scripture knowledge their permanent hermeneutic-exegetical study, which will help them in a critical and constructive approach to the modern world.
