Description of the course	The objectives of the course are to familiarize students with Ratzinger's personal understanding of Jesus of Nazareth through interpretation of the Bible in the context of the faith of the Church.			
Learning outcomes of the course	<p>After the completion of the requirements, students will be able to do the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - recognize the contribution of the historically critical method but also its limitations in the interpretation of the texts of the New Testament; - present “canonical exegesis” as a method that interprets the Gospel in the light of the whole Holy Scripture in which Jesus Christ is its hermeneutical key; - understand that Jesus can only be properly understood through his relationship with the Heavenly Father; - interpret Jesus as the “new” Moses, who, as the only son, stands before the face of the Father, and in him the Father communicates to mankind; - expose the secret of the Kingdom of God, which is fully revealed in the person and work of Jesus Christ, and which does not impose the policy of violence but instead the free acceptance of Jesus in the world; - identify the main purpose of the parable in the discovery of Jesus’ divine Sonship, in which Jesus shows that only he “knows” the Father and wants to bring his Kingdom to the world;
