

Prof. Josip Faričić, PhD

Curriculum vitae

Josip Faričić was born in Zadar on June 16, 1976. In 1998 he completed the graduate study of geography and history at the Faculty of Philosophy of the University of Zadar. In 2003 he earned master's degree and in 2006 doctoral degree at the Faculty of Science of the University of Zagreb.

After finishing the study he worked as a substitute geography teacher in elementary and high schools in Zadar. In 1999 he started working as a junior researcher on the project *Geographic bases of the development of small Croatian islands* led by prof. dr. sc. Damir Magaš at the Department of Geography of the University of Zadar. He was promoted into the positions of senior research assistant, assistant professor and associate professor at the same department. In 2003 and 2004 he held lectures in *Maritime Geography* at the Faculty of Maritime Studies of the University of Rijeka. From 2005 to 2011 he held lectures in the same course at the Department of Maritime Studies of the University of Zadar. He has been a full professor at the Department of Geography of the University of Zadar since 2015. He holds lectures in several core and elective courses: *Mathematical Geography*, *Cartography*, *Geography of Religions* and *Maritime Geography*. He was the head of the Department of Geography from 2009 to 2011, and vice-rector of the University of Zadar from 2011 to 2015.

He is the author or coauthor of about a hundred scientific and professional papers published in journals, proceedings and books (as chapters) from the fields of cartography, historic and maritime geography and geography of religions. He is particularly interested in the geography of islands. He wrote a book *Geography of Northern Dalmatian Islands* (2012). He actively participated in a number of scientific conferences and other scientific activities in Croatia and abroad.

He edited several scientific monographs and participated in editing several conference proceedings. He was a member of the editorial board of scientific magazine *Geoadria*, and presently he is a member of the editorial board of the journal *Cartography and Geoinformation* and journal *Croatian Geographic Bulletin*. He was a mentor to about twenty students in writing their diploma works. He was a co-mentor on one doctoral dissertation and mentor on three doctoral dissertations. He reviewed about forty scientific papers and several scholarly books and textbooks.

He has been a full member of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts. He is a member of several professional and cultural associations: Croatian Geographical Society, Croatian Cartographic Society and *Matrix Croatica*. For several years he had been a secretary of the Croatian Geographical Society - Zadar, and then also the president of the same association (from 2010 to 2012). He has been a honorary member of the Croatian Cartographic Society from 2014.
