

We are inviting all interested undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate students, as well as all other interested individuals, to take part in the International Student Conference on Underwater Archaeology, which will be held at the University of Zadar under the name of ANNONA 2015 from 13 November to 15 November 2015.

Support for this conference has been provided by some of the most renowned scientists with long term experience in maritime archeological research, including Irena Radić Rossi, PhD. (University of Zadar), Giulia Boetto, PhD. (CNRS - University Aix-Marseille) and Jens Auer, PhD. (University of Southern Denmark).

The main goal of this conference is to give students a chance to present their experience in participating in projects related to the research and preservation of underwater cultural heritage. The international character of this conference prompts students to get to know each other and cooperate in the future, discuss relevant topics and exchange information and ideas in the area of underwater archaeology.

## Topics of interest:

- Maritime trading through historical periods;
- Ships and cargos;
- Harbor installations: and
- New underwater archaeology research results.

The main theme for this conference is trade, which has, since Prehistory to the Modern Age, taken place not only at sea, but also through inland waterways. By virtue of the ship, shipload and harbor installation findings, it is possible to reconstruct ship routes and analyze the dynamics of maritime and river trading through historical periods, in order to perceive changes which have occurred through history.

For our conference logo we have chosen a drawing of a Lamboglia 2 type amphora, the most commonly found type at Eastern Adriatic underwater archaeological sites. This kind of amphora has become an unofficial symbol of archaeological research in Croatian underwater.

Authors are solicited to submit their presentation summary, of 200 to 300 words using the provided form, to the e-mail address annona.zadar@gmail.com no later than 15 September 2015. Each presentation should be planned for 15 minutes, followed by a 5 minute discussion period. Papers can be registered as either individual works or co-authored. For the registration, it is necessary to provide key words, and to list sources.

Students will get to know each other through various activities which include sight-seeing, visiting institutions in charge of research and preservation of underwater cultural heritage, participating in a student banquet, and diving as a group at the archaeological site near Brušnjak island, in the immediate vicinity of Pag island.

The conference participation fee is €30, which includes the conference, banquet, and diving expenses. Participation fee should be paid no later than 1. October 2015 on the following bank account, as a confirmation of participating at the conference.
