

Zoran Šikić was born on 17 February 1964 in Starigrad-Paklenica. He graduated from the Faculty of Forestry, University of Zagreb in 1987, and also from the Faculty of Forestry, University of Zagreb on 16 March 2012 he defended his doctoral dissertation "Soil and Water in Sustainable Management in Protected Areas of Nature on the Example of the Vrana Lake Nature Park". He was State Secretary for Nature Protection at the Ministry of Culture, Assistant Minister at the Head of the Nature Protection Directorate, and Director of the Paklenica National Park. He was a member of the Working Group for Pre-Accession Negotiations with the EU for Chapter 27. Environment. On 17 November 2014 he was elected to Assistant Professor, on 20 April 2020 to Associate Professor, and on 30 September 2025 to Full Professor at the Department of Ecology, Agronomy and Aquaculture, University of Zadar. From 1 September 2012, when he was employed at the Department of Ecology, Agronomy and Aquaculture of the University of Zadar until his election to Assistant Professor, he held the position of Senior Assistant. He is registered in the scientific register of the Ministry of Science, Education and Youth of the Republic of Croatia under registration number 337201. In his scientific, educational and professional activities, he focuses on the protection of nature and the environment, management of protected areas, sustainable management with an emphasis on water and forest resources. Since 4 June 2024, he has been a member of the Executive Board of the Scientific Council for Agriculture and Forestry of the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts.
